## Camp Lucy

This is an impeccably maintained ranch resort with luxury accommodations and breathtaking venues. Owned by Dripping Springs entrepreneur and well-known antiques dealer Whit Hanks and named for his mother, Lucy Hanks, these 275 acres above Onion Creek have a cherished history as an idyllic family getaway. Among its treasures: the largest live oak tree in Hays County, peaceful gardens, extraordinary stonework, a hand-hewn Amish barn, a 1930s French Colonial church roofed with 1920s Ludowicki tile repurposed from the old Bexar County Courthouse and an 1880s chapel from Vietnam salvaged and brought to America piece-by-piece.



## Rancho Mirando

This jewel on the famed Devil's Backbone is a living work of art, and you will enjoy a personal tour by its family of curators and resident artists, Donna, Leslie and Mark. Even if you've been to one of the many community events hosted here, we guarantee a totally different experience! Crowning these 50 acres are abundant lavender plants and other herbs and botanicals, olive trees, roses, terraces, verdant lawns, custom ironworks, a charming hacienda and, of course, 360-degree vistas.
